Maharashtra Lok Sabha Elections 2024: Is Shinde Sena Planning A Ghar Wapsi?

Mumbai: The results of Maharashtra Lok Sabha Elections 2024 were announced on June 4 after a fierce electoral fight between the Mahayuti and the Maha Vikas Aghadi alliances. Amid the ongoing political turmoil at the national level over forming a new government, a new storm is brewing in state with speculations that Shinde Sena MPs are in touch with Uddhav Thackeray and may switch sides to join I.N.D.I.A bloc. According to a report by ABP news citing sources, several MPs from chief minister Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena are reportedly in contact with Uddhav Thackeray in an attempt to jump ship again and join the Sena UBT party. According to political experts associated with the news channel, it is suggested that the Shiv Sena MPs have considered joining hands with Uddhav Thackeray after their party failed to perform well during the recent polls.

Congress Leader Shares ABP's Report On X

However, it is unclear how many and which MPs are particularly in contact with the Sena UBT party chief. Con-

gress party's social media head Supriya Shrinat shared a clip from the ABP News channel's morning show which claimed about the recent developments between the two Shiv Sena factions. Taking the clip on her official account on X, Shrinat said, "it had to happen! According to sources: Many MPs of Shiv Sena Shinde are in contact with Uddhav Thackeray." These reports have now raised widespread speculations around the political circles which will further result in a notable shift in the state's political dynamics.

Shiv Sena Bags 7 Out Of 15 Seats Contested

The ruling Shiv Sena has won seven of the 15 Lok Sabha seats it contested in Maharashtra, including Chief Minister Eknath Shinde's political turf Thane, but lost two constituencies in Mumbai to its rival Shiv Sena (UBT). Shinde's next challenge will be the crucial assembly polls slated for later this year which will decide which faction is the 'real' Shiv Sena post the 2022 split in the party -- one controlled by him or his arch rival Uddhav



Thackeray. Of the 15 seats, the Shiv Sena was in a direct contest with its rival Shiv Sena (UBT) in 13 and won six of them -- Thane, Kalyan, Hatkanagale, Buldhana, Aurangabad and Maval.

'Muslims Prefer...': Assam CM Himanta After NDA Loss In 3 Assam Seats



Assam Lok Sabha Results: Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said on Wednesday that the Congress has become the preferred party of the minorities in the state. This comes a day after the Lok Sabha election results were declared. In Assam, out of the 14 Lok Sabha seats, the saffron party emerged victorious with nine, and the Congress secured three. United People's Party, Liberal (UPPL), and Asom Gana Parishad

bagged one seat each. Elaborating on the Lok Sabha results in the north-eastern state, Sarma said that in this election, the grand old party had the monopoly of the Muslim vote in Assam. During his interaction with mediapersons, the Assam CM laid emphasis on the result of the Nagaon and Dhubri Lok Sabha seats bagged by the Congress and claimed that earlier Muslim people were the prime voters for Muslims in the state for the grand old party and the AIUDF, but this time the Congress had a monopoly on Muslim votes. "I think earlier Muslim people were the prime voters for Mohammed Badruddin Ajmal (AIUDF chief) and the Congress in Assam. This time, the Congress had the monopoly over the Muslim vote in Assam. Regarding the vote, there had previously been a dispute between the two parties. This

time it is victorious in Nagaon and Dhubri. In Nagaon, if you see, we are leading in all constituencies where Hindus live, and Pradyut Bordoloi is leading in the constituency where Muslims live," Sarma said. Speaking about the Dhubri seat, the Assam CM said, "Similarly, in the Dhubri seat, Rakibul Hussain is leading in a constituency with 11 Muslim constituencies. So Ajmal and the Congress, who can get the most votes in the minority, the Congress is definitely winning the battle. But we never have anything to do with that, we are far away from that." The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP)-led NDA attained the majority, bagging 293 seats, while the opposition bloc INDIA secured 234 seats. The BJP failed to achieve the majority of 272 seats, securing 240 seats, while on the other hand, the Congress won 98 seats.

I'm so glad I'm in a position today to take care of my sister's treatment. Imagine, if I was just a small-town girl studying in college! Whatever money I had saved for my sister's wedding is now being used for her treatment. One day I hope to help many other girls who have to face unwanted attention." The day has come. Kangana can, and I suspect she will fill the parliamentary space with her fiery presence. A leading director, who crossed swords with the celluloid Rani Of Jhansi says, "She has found her true vocation. Good luck to her."



Violence hits West Bengal after Trinamool's victory in Lok Sabha polls



A day after the Trinamool Congress (TMC) registered a resounding victory in West Bengal with 29 seats in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, several incidents of post-poll violence have been reported across the state. About a dozen houses and a BJP office were allegedly vandalised by goons, armed with iron rods and guns, in Barasat constituency's Madhyamgram in North 24 Parganas district. Trinamool called it a clash between rival factions within the BJP. The police came to the spot along with CAPF jawans. However, the miscreants allegedly returned and ransacked the area after the security forces had left. The police is yet to arrest anyone related to the incident. Meanwhile, Barrackpore constituency's Bhatpara has also been hit with violence. Within hours after the announcement of the TMC's win in Barrackpore, miscreants raided BJP workers' homes and ransacked them, causing an atmosphere of fear in the area. Bombs were also hurled in the region allegedly by TMC supporters. In Coochbehar's Natabari, in the northern part of West Bengal, a BJP supporter allegedly attacked a TMC worker with a gun. A video has gone viral where local villagers can be seen chasing the accused while he flashes his gun. In Nadia district's Shantipur, a TMC youth leader's house was hurled with bombs. A BJP agent's house was vandalized in South 24 Parganas' Narendrapur. In Durgapur, a CPI(M) leader's daughter's shop was plundered. A BJP worker's house was bombed and vandalized in Howrah. These incidents have created a tense atmosphere in several pockets across West Bengal where central forces are deployed until June 19. The state has a notorious history of political violence with post-poll violence a big menace. After Trinamool's landslide victory in the 2021 state assembly elections, post-poll violence had taken a drastic turn in West Bengal. Scores of opposition party workers had to leave their homes for hiding.

Election campaigning by Arvind Kejriwal shows he is not suffering from life-threatening ailments: Delhi court

A Delhi court said on Wednesday that extensive election campaigning and meetings done by Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal during the recently concluded Lok Sabha polls shows that he is not suffering from any serious or life-threatening ailments and he is not entitled to interim bail under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). Special Judge (PC Act) Kaveri Baweja of the Rouse Avenue Court observed that Diabetes or even type-2 Diabetes are not serious diseases that will entitle him to interim bail. "Diabetes or even type-2 Diabetes cannot be said to be so serious an ailment so as to entitle him to the relief claimed. Further, the extensive campaigning tours and related meetings/events undertaken by Arvind Kejriwal as highlighted during the course of arguments also indicate that he



does not appear to be suffering from any serious or 'life threatening' ailment so as to entitle him to the beneficial provision as contained in proviso to Section 45 PMLA," the Court said. Judge Baweja made the observation while denying interim bail to Kejriwal. She said that the Delhi Chief Minister is seeking bail for diagnosis of an "anticipated ailment" and for conducting tests to determine whether high ketone lev-

els or the stated weight loss could have caused Diabetic Ketoacidosis. The Court said such tests can be conducted while he is in custody. The Court revived the AIIMS medical board constituted earlier by it to examine Kejriwal and to conduct medical tests as it deems fit within three days. "Upon receipt of the Test Reports, the Medical Board shall prescribe the further necessary treatment as may be required and the Jail Authorities shall ensure that the treatment so prescribed by the Medical Board is provided to the Applicant forthwith, under intimation to this court," the Court ordered. Senior Advocate N Hariharan and advocate Vivek Jain appeared for Arvind Kejriwal. Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, Additional Solicitor General SV Raju and Special Counsel Zoheb Hossain represented the ED.

NIPL ties up with Peru's Central Bank



NPCI International Payments Limited (NIPL) and the Central Reserve Bank of Peru (BCRP) announced a partnership to deploy a UPI-like payments system in Peru, the payments corporation said in a press statement. This makes Peru, the first country in South America to adopt the Unified Payment Interface (UPI) technology. "We consider that this

new infrastructure will play a fundamental role in fostering innovation and in allowing new participants to enter the Peruvian ecosystem," said Julio Velarde, Governor of the BCRP. "This will undoubtedly offer new and accessible payment services to everyone, especially the unbanked population in Peru, complementing the existing payments industry," Julio Velarde emphasized that the support of the Reserve Bank of India has been a cornerstone of this agreement. "Our partnership with the BCRP aims to strengthen Peru's financial infrastructure, to foster economic growth," said Ritesh Shukla, CEO of NPCI International. "We will be working together to address our common objective of promoting digital payments,

financial inclusion, cost optimization, and transparency in the payment landscape, with scope for further scalability and adaptability, to embrace future technological advancements and market demands." The development follows UPI entering other markets such as France, Sri Lanka, Singapore, and Mauritius, according to a Business Standard report. In January 2024, NPCI announced the launch of the UPI-PayNow, enabling Indians to receive remittances from Singapore. In February, it announced a partnership with e-commerce and proximity payments company Lyra to enable UPI acceptance in France, and this month, UPI services were rolled out in Sri Lanka and Mauritius, the report read.

ISIS Style: BJP Shares Video of DMK Workers Beheading Goat With Annamalai Image to Celebrate Win

Coimbatore: Terming it 'ISIS-style' hatred, the BJP on Thursday shared a shocking video clip of DMK workers allegedly beheading a goat with the picture of K Annamalai to celebrate their victory in Coimbatore. Annamalai is the son of a farmer and his family rears goats. In the past, DMK has mocked Annamalai over Goat farming. "He added that if BJP workers did the same to an opposition member, they would call it 'fascism' but 'from Bengal to Tamil Nadu when there is such vile and hatred, pseudo-liberals and 'Save constitution brigade' is silent. Will TN police act? Will the media report this? This is not symbolic hatred it is incitement



of violence." **Annamalai Loses Coimbatore** Tamil Nadu BJP chief and Lok Sabha election candidate K Annamalai faced defeat in the Coimbatore Lok Sabha seat against DMK rival Ganapathy Rajkumar who won by the margin of nearly one lakh votes. Annamalai, a former IPS officer of the Karnataka cadre, joined the BJP in 2019 and became the president of the party's Tamil Nadu unit in 2021. After defeat, the IPS-turned-politician took to X and wrote, "I bow down to the people of the Coimbatore Parliamentary constituency & thank

the 4.5 Lakh voters who bestowed their faith in NDA & BJPTamilnadu. You believed in the vision of our Hon PM Shri Narendra Modi avl for his Viksit Bharat. You have given us historic votes in the history of Coimbatore PC for NDA, and still, we were short of the winning mark." Congratulating the winning DMK candidate, he said, "I congratulate & convey my best wishes to the winning DMK candidate of Coimbatore, Thiru Raj Kumar avl.
