Captain Anshuman Singh's Widow 'Planning To Flee To Australia With Kirti Chakra, Money', Alleges Father



The father of Captain Anshuman Singh, who was awarded Kirti Chakra posthumously, has alleged that his daughter-in-law and widow of Anshuman, Smriti Singh is planning to flee from the country with the gallantry award and the ex gratia money. Speaking to ABP News, Captain Anshuman's father claimed that Smriti duped his son in the name of love. "She didn't love him," he said. On July 7, Smriti and her mother-in-law accepted the second-highest peacetime gallantry award, Kirti Chakra, from President Droupadi Murmu. Following the investiture ceremony, Smriti spoke about her personal life saying her meeting with Captain Anshuman at an engineering college was "love at first sight". Captain Anshuman's father also claimed that Smriti was planning to flee with the gallantry award and ex gratia money to Australia. The allegation comes just days after the martyred soldier's parents claimed that their daughter-in-law took away the gallantry award along with their son's clothes and photo album with her to her home in Punjab's Gurdaspur. Reports in the media had also suggested that Smriti had changed the permanent address listed in her husband's official documents from Lucknow to Gurdaspur ensuring any communication regarding Singh takes place with her. Captain Anshuman's father also called for a change in the 'next of kin' law of the Army. This law determines who would inherit assets and receive medical updates if something happens to a person in service. Similar to the concept of a nominee, the NOK rules determine, who gets the ex gratia as well. When a person joins the Army, their parent's or guardian's names are registered in the NOK. Once married, the spouse's name replaces the parent's name as their next kin. Recently, a derogatory comment by a social media user against Smriti Singh sparked outrage with the National Commission for Women (NCW) demanding strict action against the individual.

This Will Be My Huge Insult, I Will Not Be Able to Tolerate It

Stuck at the eye of the storm in Maharashtra, IAS probationer Puja Khedkar is getting into more trouble with every passing day. For the uninitiated, she was transferred from Pune to Washim district following a letter to the General Administration Department by Pune Collector Dr Suhas Diwase. The letter highlighted that she made demands for a separate cabin and staff during her posting in Pune. She allegedly used a red beacon light on the Audi car and also got 'Maharashtra Government' written on it without permission. After the transfer, her OBC and disability certificates came under scrutiny, and even the Central government constituted a single-member committee "to verify the candidature" of Khedkar. Later, various issues arose, including an old video of her mother allegedly threatening farmers with a gun, which went viral. The message was written by Khedkar after she was asked to vacate the antechamber of the additional collector at the office. While she nar-

rated the whole scenario which led her to taking up the space in the chamber, she also appealed to the collector, saying, "If you now ask me to vacate the chamber, I will be insulted and I will not be able to tolerate the insult. That is why I request you to let me continue sitting in the same chamber." She also noted that IAS probationers like her got their own offices at their respective places and vehicles, and thus she also feels like having the separate space to sit and vehicle. She also mentioned that the chambers of resident district collectors were vacated for probationary officers. The message sent on WhatsApp has been attached in the letter written by Diwase to GAD.

Income Tax e-filing portal glitches return; ITR filing problems mount

The deadline for filing Income Tax Return (ITR) is approaching and glitches in the online Income Tax e-filing portal are rising once again. The challenge has risen to such a level that the Income Tax Bar Association Calcutta has dispatched four letters to the Central Processing Unit of the Income Tax Department in Bengaluru for quick redressal as filing tax has become a real challenge. "The challenges are rising like last year. Sometimes the portal won't just respond, sometimes OTPs would not be generated. Even the nature of the problems can't be predicted," said secretary of the Income Tax Bar Association Calcutta.

Huge number of taxpayers

As many as 8.18 crore ITRs were filed in AY 2023-24 and therefore, glitches put a huge number of taxpayers at terrible discomfort.

Last date to file ITR 2 weeks away

The last date of filing ITR is July 31. Taxpayers are penalised with late fees that can be as much as Rs 5,000 and carry additional interest if one misses the deadline. The problem

seems to be a tragic action replay of the troubles in 2022, when a countrywide chorus put the finance ministry in deep embarrassment and they were forced to pull up Infosys - the company responsible for the maintenance of the site - publicly.

"Poor services" flayed

"We are compelled to give you a third reminder due to poor services of the portal and resulting hindrances in filing Income Tax Returns for AY 2024-25. It has become a serious concern now that the income tax portal glitches are still continuing without any satisfactory resolution. For the last few days, the portal service is mostly unavailable during the office hours. The situation is ignominious for professionals who have taken the responsibility of filing their clients' IT returns," wrote the Bar Association from Kolkata in a letter sent on July 13. "Due to regular crash the data and information cannot be synchronised which is causing severe hindrance in the process," the letter added.

Infosys in the dock

The company which upgraded the



portal and maintains it, Infosys has been at the receiving end of a torrent of criticisms for the past couple of years but is still grappling with the problems. On June 7, 2022, tagging Infosys CEO Salil Parekh, Income Tax Department authorities had written on their official social media handle "Issue relating to the search functionality of the e-filing website has come to our notice. The Income Tax Department is seized of the matter. @Infosys has been directed to look into it & @Infosys has confirmed that they are resolving the issue on priority. @SalilParekh." No such response has been evident so far this year even as the trouble continues said income tax practitioner Manojit Banerjee.

BJP's Amit Malviya draws ire over remarks on assassination of Congress leaders



A BJP functionary courted controversy on Monday by saying that Congress leaders were assassinated "for the political decisions they took", triggering a backlash from the grand old party. During a television debate on the assassination attempt on former US president Donald Trump, Amit Malviya, the IT cell head of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), claimed that the Congress leaders, and particularly Rahul Gandhi, have been encouraging violence against Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Malviya drew parallel between the language used by the Democrats in the United States against Donald Trump and by the Congress leaders in India against Prime Minister Modi. "Before the Congress claims that their own leaders got assassinated, I want to remind them that they were assassinated for the political decisions that they took," he added. "What an atrocious, obnoxious and disgraceful statement by this man. If the self-anointed non-biological PM has any shred of decency he should sack this guy right away," Congress general secretary Jairam Ramesh, in charge of communications, posted on X. Congress' media and publicity department head Pawan Khera blasted Amit Malviya and asked Prime Minister Modi whether he endorses this view. "According to this BJP motormouth, Mahatma Gandhi, Indira ji, Rajiv ji, Sardar Beant Singh and the entire Congress leadership of Chattisgarh deserved to be assassinated for the political decisions they took," Khera said on X. "The only political decision these martyrs took was to live and die for India. Buffoons of BJP will never understand that sentiment. Do we need more proof of the anti-national mindset of the BJP??" he added. The BJP on Sunday had targeted Rahul Gandhi, the Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, following the assassination attempt on former US president Donald Trump. Malviya posted some past comments of Rahul Gandhi saying the Congress leader has used similar rhetoric against Modi, such as calling him a "dictator", that Trump's critics like Democrat leader and US President Joe Biden have. "Third Time Fail Rahul Gandhi has often encouraged and justified violence against Prime Minister Modi, who he has lost election to, several times now. How can India ever forget how Punjab Police, then under the Congress, deliberately compromised PM's security, when his convoy was left stranded on a flyover," Malviya had said. Hitting back at the BJP, Pawan Khera said, "Cheap politics should not be played on the issue of security of leaders. The Congress party lost Mahatma ji to Right Wing terrorists. We lost two prime ministers at the hands of terrorists. We lost our entire Chhattisgarh leadership to Left Wing terrorists, under the watch of the BJP government."

Muharram procession in Srinagar becomes a show of solidarity with Palestinians

A thousand-strong Muharram procession in Srinagar's city centre turned into a show of solidarity with Palestinians on Monday, with protesters defying the administration by waving Palestinian flags and chanting anti-Israel slogans. Lieutenant governor Manoj Sinha's administration has strictly barred pro-Palestinian demonstrations in Kashmir since the outbreak of the Gaza war and even shut down Jamia Masjid on several occasions to prevent an outpouring of support for Palestine. The administration on Monday allowed the Shia community to take out a procession to mark the eighth day of mourning of the death of Prophet Mohammed's grandson on the traditional Guru Bazar-Dalgate route in Srinagar. The procession, banned for more than three decades, was allowed for the first time last year in an attempt to forge relations with the Valley's Shia minority. There were no restrictions on the procession this year too, but mourners

were directed to keep it strictly apolitical. The procession started from Guru Bazar and passed through the designated route via Jehangir Chowk and Maulana Azad Road before culminating at Dalgate. The procession was bigger this time and continued for much of the day although the organisers were granted a limited time window to avoid inconveniencing the commuters. Many in the procession waved Palestinian flags and chanted slogans in support of Palestine as they walked slowly through the city centre. Traffic on city roads was diverted and barricades were erected at multiple places to facilitate the procession. Muharram processions were banned after the eruption of militancy in Kashmir as authorities were apprehensive that separatists might misuse the large gathering for ulterior motives. Spearheaded by a separatist Shia group, the procession always used to metamorphose into a pro-Azadi



demonstration. The group would routinely defy police to take out the procession in the face of tear gas shells and cane charges. Kashmiri Sunnis, who form around half of Jammu and Kashmir's population, were in the vanguard of the separatist movement and got support from other Muslim communities. Many believe the government has all along tried to woo other Muslim groups - Kashmiri Shias, Gujjars and Paharis - to break the "Muslim unity" but without much success.

Jyotirmath Shankaracharya After Video Of Him Blessing PM During Ambani Wedding Goes Viral



Shankaracharya Swami Avimukteshwaranand on Monday reacted to an Ambani wedding video showing Prime Minister Narendra Modi seeking his blessings by touching his feet. Jyotirmath Head Seer said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi is not his enemy and he blesses anyone who comes to him. This comes after a video surfaced on social media in which Prime Minister Modi after

blessing the newlyweds Anant Ambani and Radhika Merchant, could be seen approaching the Shankaracharya. While Shankaracharya Swami Avimukteshwaranand is known for his criticism of PM Modi, the cordial interaction at the Ambani wedding grabbed attention. As soon as PM Modi bowed down and touched his feet, the seer could be seen blessing him and gifting him a 'Rudraskh's' bead garland. "Yes, he (PM Modi) came to me and did a 'Pranaam'. It is our rule that we will bless whoever comes to us. Narendra Modi ji is not our enemy. We are his well-wishers and always speak for his welfare. If he makes a mistake, then we also point that out to them," the Shankaracharya said while speaking to on Monday. Earlier in January, Shankaracharya Swami Avimukteshwaranand had rejected the invita-

tion to the Ram Mandir Pran Pratishtha ceremony, citing the incompleteness of the temple. "It is not right to instil life (pran-pratishtha) in the body without its head or eyes. This goes against our scriptures. Hence, I will not be going there because if I go there people will say scriptures have been violated in front of me. Hence, we have raised the issue with responsible people, especially with the members of the Ayodhya Trust -- that the celebration should be done once the temple is fully constructed. Discussion has been going on," the Shankaracharya had said. The seer had also criticised PM Modi on the issue: "Modiji will inaugurate the Temple, touch the idol... what will I do"? ... clap? my post also has some dignity.... why should I go to an event which is not accordance to the religious scriptures?"

Snakes were guarding 'Ratna Bhandar' of Puri's Jagannath temple? HC Judge reveals stunning truth

The Ratna Bhandar, also called the revered treasury, at Lord Jagannath temple in Puri, Odisha, was reopened on Sunday. The state government comprised a team of 11 members to conduct the inventory of valuables in the Bhitari Bhandar (Inner Treasury) and Bahar Treasury (Outer Treasury). The doors of it were opened after 46 years. Odisha High Court judge Biswanath Rath, after visiting the inner chamber treasury, said in an interview that the team could enter the premises after 'cutting the locks in the presence of the magistrate and others.' Judge Rath also commented on the reports regarding the presence of snakes inside the chamber, reported news agency IANS. He refuted the reports and myths around the Ratna Bhandar. "As seven to eight members of temple management are part of the team, they



are busy as the Bahuda Yatra preparations have started, so we couldn't get more time for further checking and shifting of the ornaments. So we decided to fix another date for the shifting of the ornaments and precious stones of the deities," Judge Rath said. Arambinda Padhee, the chief administrator of Shree

Jagannath Temple Administration (SJTA), asserted that the jewellery stored in the outer treasury had been moved to a temporary strong room inside the temple premises and was sealed in presence of a magistrate. He added, "We entered the outer chamber of the Ratna Bhandar after opening the locks with the keys kept with Gajapati Maharaj, the king of Puri, SJTA and the Bhandar Mekap servitor. On this auspicious occasion, the Chief Minister's Office also posted a statement on X (Formerly Twitter). He said, "On the wish of Lord Jagannath, the Odia community, with the identity of 'Odia Asmita', has started making efforts to move forward. On your wish, the four gates of the Jagannath temples were earlier opened. Today, on your wish, the Ratna Bhandar was opened after 46 years for a greater purpose."
