IAS Tina Dabi often grabs headlines for several reasons pertaining to her personal and professional life. The Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) 2015 topper is known for her work in various districts in Rajasthan. Now, the civil servant made it to the headlines after a video of her went viral on social media. In the video, she is seen awestruck after seeing a woman Sarpanch giving a speech in English. The woman sarpanch was seen wearing a Rajputi dress and veil. She approached the podium to address a gathering. After reaching the podium as the woman Sarpanch started speaking in English, everyone, including IAS Tina Dabi, was left surprised after wit-



nessing her fluency and command over the language. "I am glad to be part of this day. First of all, I welcome our collector, Tina ma'am," the woman said during her speech. As she ended her speech, all the people gave the woman

a big round of applause. The video went viral on social media and was widely shared by several users. The woman sarpanch is said to be Sonu Kanwar, who gave the surprising speech in Rajasthan's Barmer. Dabi was recently transferred to Barmer as Collector. The IAS officer was earlier the District Collector for Jaisalmer. While her husband, IAS Pradeep Gawande, was appointed the District Collector of Jalore, approximately 150 km away from Barmer. IAS Tina is a high-profile bureaucrat whose wedding to fellow IAS officer Pradeep Gawande last year grabbed attention. She rose to fame in 2015 when she topped the UPSC Civil Services examination.

The Andhra Pradesh government has suspended senior IPS officer Vishal Gunni for his alleged involvement in "hastily arresting" and "harassing" a Mumbai-based actor-cum-model without proper investigation in a case filed against her. During the alleged incident, IPS Gunni was Deputy Commissioner of Police (Vijayawada). The action came after an inquiry revealed his role in the alleged harassment of the model. Besides this, the state government also suspended two other senior IPS officers. The woman accused the police officials of threatening her with dire consequences during the previous government if she did not with-

draw a case she earlier filed against a top executive of a corporation in Mumbai.

Who is IPS Vishal Gunni?

He is a 2010 batch IPS officer of Andhra Pradesh cadre. He cracked the UPSC civil services exam in 2009 and secured All India Rank (AIR) 439. He has been serving as a civil servant for the last 14 years. IPS Gunni was also the deputy inspector general (DIG) in Visakhapatnam. Previously, he also served as the Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP) in the rural district of Visakhapatnam from 2013 to 2015. Reports suggest he was born and brought up in Bengaluru. He



holds a bachelor's degree in Arts from St Joseph College, Bengaluru. The IPS officer is quite active on social media. He has 145K followers on Instagram wherein he often shares pictures from his personal and professional life.

Duplicate hair oil manufacturing unit busted in Berhampur, name of the brand will shock you



A duplicate hair oil manufacturing unit has been busted in Lane No-4 of Shastri Nagar area of Berhampur City of Ganjam district today. Acting on the allegation, the Badabazar Police conducted a raid and busted the adulterated hair oil manufacturing unit that was using the name, logo and

copyrights of a branded hair oil company of the country. During the raid, the cops also seized a huge quantity of raw materials and machines used to prepare the duplicate hair oil. Besides, several packaging items including the bottles and tin containers of different shapes and colours were also seized by the police. The raid was carried out based on allegations of the Kolkata-based Shalimar's Coconut Hair Oil Company, which produces the original hair oil and owns the copyrights. "About four to five months ago we got to know that the brand, logo, design, colour and copy-

rights of Shalimar's was misused with fake oil. However, we had no clue where the oil was manufactured. After we filed a complaint around a month ago, police started an investigation and busted the duplicate oil manufacturing unit today," said Somnath Banerjee, the legal advisor of Shalimar's Company, while speaking to the media persons. "They (the fake oil manufacturing unit) kept everything same except the product inside (oil). While the oil of the Shalimar's is prepared with original coconut and in natural process, the duplicate oil was being prepared with Liquid paraffin," he added.

'Vande Metro' Renamed As 'Namo Bharat Rapid Rail,' PM Modi To Flag Off First Service In Gujarat Today

Ahead of its debut, the Indian Railways announced the renaming of the 'Vande Metro' service to 'Namo Bharat Rapid Rail' on Monday, September 16. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will flag off India's first Namo Bharat Rapid Rail besides several other Vande Bharat trains during his visit to Gujarat today. The inaugural journey will commence from Bhuj and reach Ahmedabad, covering 359 kilometres in just 5 hours and 45 minutes. The regular service for the passengers will launch on September 17, with a ticket price of Rs 455 for the entire journey, making the journey cost-effective for commuters. The train will run at a maximum speed of 110 kmph and will stop at several sta-



tions - Anjar, Gandhidham, Bhachau, Samakhiali, Halvad, Dhrangadhra, Viramgam, Chandlodiya, Sabarmati and Kalupur (Ahmedabad station).

Redefining Concept Of Metro Travel

With its launch, the Indian Railways has redefined the concept of metro travel. Unlike traditional metros that operate between urban

stations, the Namo Bharat Rapid Rail will cover inter-city destinations, bridging urban centres with surrounding areas. It caters to a broader travel range, unlike urban metro services. It will carry up to 2,058 standing passengers, with seating arrangement for 1,150. The train comes fitted with cushioned sofas for seating and has air-conditioned coaches. Although many people claim that it resembles the Vande Bharat Express, the reality is that features more suburban metro trains as it comes with automatic sliding doors and engines at both ends. It will also be unreserved, allowing passengers to purchase the travel ticket just before its departure.

'Sandeep used to gather transgender people's numbers from Facebook to form relationships, biting, pinching, and hitting them'

Sandeep Ghosh has been arrested in connection with the RG Kar case. Along with financial embezzlement, he was also arrested in the Tilottama incident on Saturday. On one hand, the CBI is conducting an investigation and uncovering explosive information, while on the other hand, Sandeep's neighbors and friends are gradually starting to speak out against him. Now, a prominent activist from the transgender community has made explosive allegations against Sandeep. According to them, Sandeep did not respect the transgender community and would form physical relationships with multiple individuals, only to later subject them to abuse. Kazi Ali Aftab stated, "He would gather phone numbers of transgender people through Facebook and call them over. He would then form relationships with them. However, I don't think there is anything inappropriate about the way he formed these relationships. But we have objections to how he expressed his sexuality." He further alleged, "He used to engage in behaviors such as biting, pinching, and hitting. He has done this to three members of our community. However, they could not go to the police at that time because he was influential and also a doctor. He was recognized in society." The individual also claimed, "When we tried to file a complaint with the police, they would likely say that you entered into the relationship voluntarily. In that case, regardless of who the victim is, they end up being blamed."

India Plays a Key Role in Controlling Bangladesh's Market Prices



An interim government has already been formed in Bangladesh. However, despite the government beginning its work, the market prices in Bangladesh remain unstable. The prices of essential food items, including eggs and potatoes, have been rising sharply.

India's Major Role in Controlling Bangladesh's Market Prices: A few days ago, the price of eggs in Bangladesh had skyrocketed to 15-16 taka per piece due to a shortage in supply compared to the demand. In this situation, India extended its helping hand by exporting 231,040 eggs to Bangladesh. As a result, the price of eggs in the Bangladeshi market dropped to 7-8 taka per piece. After aiding with egg supplies, India is now exporting potatoes to Bangladesh. According to available information, 10 importers from Bangladesh have received import permits (IP) to import potatoes through the Hili land port in Dinajpur. This was confirmed by Yusuf Ali, a senior official at the Hili land port, last Friday morning. He mentioned that to stabilize potato prices in the Bangladeshi market, 10 traders from the Hili port have been granted permission to import potatoes. He also stated that these importers had previously applied for the import permits. With the process nearing completion, potato imports from India will begin soon. In a few days, Bangladeshi importers will be able to bring potatoes from India. Meanwhile, importers from the Hili port have confirmed that 10 traders have been allowed to import potatoes. Since opening the Letter of Credit (LC) takes some time, the import process will commence shortly. Once the potato imports from India begin, it is expected that the price of potatoes in Bangladesh's domestic market will drop significantly.
